2. Yellow tulle halter dress with pink butterflies and ruffles; yellow velvet bow on front of bodice; side zipper; owned by: Barb Bark.
3. Ivory tulle lace overlay lavender taffeta with 3 bows on the back.
4. Single strap, off the shoulder; white dotted Swiss over taffeta; Prom dress owned by: Mrs. Knutson; restyled for a play; served as a wedding dress.
Skirts from 1940's-pleat, A-line, straight style with a slit in the back, box pleats, wool.
5. From poodle skirt era; padded fish complete with sequined "scales"; circular skirt.
6. Chartreuse brocaded sleeveless sheath with jacket and sequin/rhinestone trim; Owned by: Mrs. Arlene Huntley who wore it to her son's wedding in 1973.
7. Purple strapless jersey knit dress; full skirt jaquar satin jacket; donated by: Mrs. Ruth Hextel; Worn through the 50's and 60's; Addie Masters.
8. 1920's Flapper dress; beige lace and chiffon; drop waist with layered skirt.
9. 1920's Dusty rose, ivory, and black.
10. Late 1970's-pink prom dress with ivory lace.
11. 1980's Prom dresses-black velvet bodice with sequins and black full skirt of heavy satin.
12. Wine-colored satin with separate sleeves; retro style.
13. Black and purple moiré bridesmaid dress; Owned by: Ellen Knutson.
14. Pumpkin sheath with lined cape; Donated by: Ruth Hextel.
15. May 25, 1975-off-the-shoulder square neckline, empire waist, blue floral; Owned by: Mrs. Huntley, who wore it in her sister's wedding.
16. 1980's-Pink lace prom dress; Owned by: Ellen Knutson.
17. 1969-Prom dress; Owned by: Mrs. Huntley.
18. 1970's-Sea foam green and floral dress with an empire waist.

19. 1950's-Pink nylon over taffeta skirt; beaded pink and ivory bodice; empire waist; cummerbund.
20. Hot pink, swirl design, strapless, wraparound dress of taffeta fabric; sarong.
21. 1968-1972-Chartruse by Kathy Bozett; Princess style; polyester fabric.
22. 1972-1973-Navy palazzo pants.
23. 1975-1977-high neck; mock turtleneck; redesigned and pinned and tucked bodice; ivory on sepia; botanical print; rust bustle (added for play 1980's era); tie around waist; Owned Mrs. Huntley's sister.
24. 1940's-Organza-pastel peach and ivory floral print; inserted high "V" waist; sweetheart neckline; blue velvet bows accent; 17 tiny pearl buttons and loops; wide ruffle at hem.
25. 1940's-Dusty blue chiffon; chiffon lined bodice; unlined neckline; _ sleeves; inverted "V" waistline; 26 covered buttons with loops down the back.
