

- In 1984, the students that participated in the spring concert were also able to go on a trip



- Throughout the 40's, Newark High School had a boy's baseball team and a boy's softball team
- We had three chorus groups (mixed chorus, boy's chorus, and girl's chorus)

- In 1942, the organization FFA got its start and so did the tradition of having a Junior class play and a Senior class play
- ▶ In 1944, SIGMA PHI got its start as well
- We had a football team for 1945 only and in the same year, GAA started as well
- ➢ In 1946, FHA started
- In 1949, Spanish replaced Latin as the language taught at our school

- > Track and Field met its demise in 1997




